If you receive Medicaid you will need to get your flu shot from your doctor's office. For those of you who receive Medicare, you will need to bring your Medicare card to Rhonda's office and sign a consent form no later than 12:00 noon on September 8th to have a shot. If you have friends or family members who want to have shots and do not receive Medicare, the cost this year is **\$31.99 for Flu Shot & \$71.99 for Pneumonia Shot.** **PLEASE NOTE:** If you need to have a pneumonia shot you must let Rhonda know no later than Wednesday, September 7th.
- **NUTRITION CLASS** – For those of you who were not able to participate in our nutrition class last month you will have another opportunity. Deb Nelson with the Purdue University Extension Program will once more teach the classes. The class dates are as follows: **September 6th, 13th, 20th & 27th**.
